
Key Values to Help Parents Focus on Success for Their Student

Do:

- Focus more on the process of learning, not always the product.
- Encourage students to advocate for themselves to speak up and tell adults what they need.
- Keep a long-term perspective.
- Maintain a healthy sleep schedule.
- Love your child for who they are.
- Value goals over grades.
- Help students find a balance and create an effective routine.
- Keep school-home lines of communication open to better support your student.
- Promote good study habits with your student.

Don't:

- Overschedule your student.
- Encourage helplessness with your student.
- Compare students to one another.
- Love students based on performance.
- Look back but help students use experiences to be better next time.
- Say negative things about student's teacher in front of the student (this can lead to confusion for your student).
